Education Programs and Production Summer Intern

The Education Programs and Production Summer Intern will participate in all aspects of the organization's education and performance programs with a primary focus on our Summer Jazz Academy.

Duties may include, but are not limited to:

- Development of camp programming
- Preparation of handbooks and other camp supplies
